**2026 Scholarship Application**

**History**

Since 1974, Thermopylae has awarded scholarships to deserving students enrolled at or entering institutions of higher learning. Initial awards were in the names of our founders- George Zanthopoulos and Louis Morkides. Subsequently, over the years Thermopylae has awarded additional scholarships in the names of our departed brothers Chris Masters, C. Dean Polites, Theophilos Constantinidis, Dr. Chris Patterson, Danny Kathopoulis, Anna and Vasilis Karavasilis, Gregory Vlassopoulos, James and Thelma Tanos and Despina Lewis. To date, the chapter has awarded over \$100,000 in scholarships. Our goal is to continuously increase the awards. In recent years, there has been increased interest in the scholarship program and in some academic years the awards were divided among the participants. Since 2010 the chapter has decided not to split the various named scholarships which allows for a greater monetary award. However, this change will produce fewer awards provided to individuals and therefore competition could be keen. Good luck!

**Rules and Regulations Governing Awards**

1. Applicant must be a member of the Thermopylae AHEPA family, Daughters of Penelope, Pandora, Maids of Athena, Sons of Pericles, **or** be sponsored by a member in good standing.
2. Applicants for scholarship will be selected from high school graduates who have been accepted by an accredited college or university **or** from students already enrolled in undergraduate studies in college or university or trade school.
3. The applicant should not be a recipient of an AHEPA Chapter 445 Scholarship the year prior to the application.
4. The scholarship award process will be based on scholastic achievement, extracurricular, and philanthropic activities. Applicants for scholarship awards will be required to complete the following:
  - a. A personal history signed by applicant and a sponsoring chapter member with clear relationship noted.
  - b. An essay, which may be up to two **typewritten** pages, on the subject provided with the application. **Handwritten submissions will be rejected.** Please email with complete application to [jcrazywind66@gmail.com](mailto:jcrazywind66@gmail.com) or mail with application.
  - c. Scholastic history with academic institution **transcripts**, certified by applicant's High School, University or College.
  - d. The school should send transcripts directly to email ([jcrazywind66@gmail.com](mailto:jcrazywind66@gmail.com)) or mailed to **AHEPA Thermopylae #445 Attn: Scholarship Chairman, PO Box 446, Broomall, PA 19008.**
  - e. Attach **resume** or **CV** with activities and honors, if applicable.
  - f. Optional financial statement, which will become a criterion when a choice must be made between applicants of equal standing. How will your education be funded? You will be notified via email if you need to complete this requirement.
5. **Applications for scholarship must be received as follows:**

  - If using mail, Mailed application hard copies and official academic transcripts must be **postmarked no later than September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026.**
